The Dean Joan Metcalf Schaefer Research Scholarships will be awarded to students who have demonstrated scholarship excellence and a continuous love of learning. These scholarships are named in honor of Dean Joan Metcalf Schaefer, Dean of Women Emerita, of the University of Southern California. The Dean Joan Metcalf Schaefer Research Scholarship provides \$1,000 of support to any non-course related research activity involving an eligible student and a faculty sponsor. The funds may either be used to (a) involve the student as a research assistant in the faculty member's project or (b) cover costs incurred by a student in the course of researching her or his own project. The Dean Joan Metcalf Schaefer Research Scholarship allows all students the opportunity to be mentored one-on-one by our faculty, and to introduce students early in their College careers to the process of serious scholarly inquiry.

Eligibility:

Applicants for the awards must be full-time students enrolled in 12 or more units majoring in the College of Letters, Arts and Sciences at the University of Southern California for the 2010-2011 academic year. In addition, they must be of junior status or above (64 units complete) in the 2010-2011 academic year and must have maintained a minimum 3.5 overall grade point average. Research awards must be under the direction of a member of the USC College faculty. Any tenured or tenure-track College faculty member is eligible to be a Dean Joan Research sponsor.
